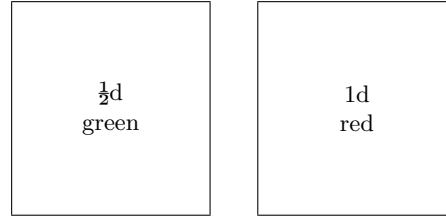
King George V issues

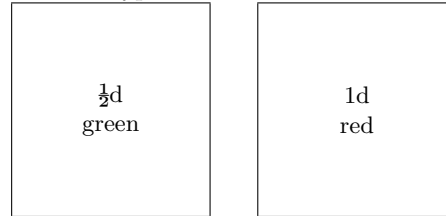

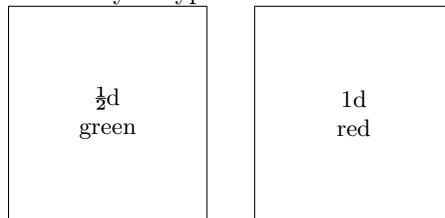

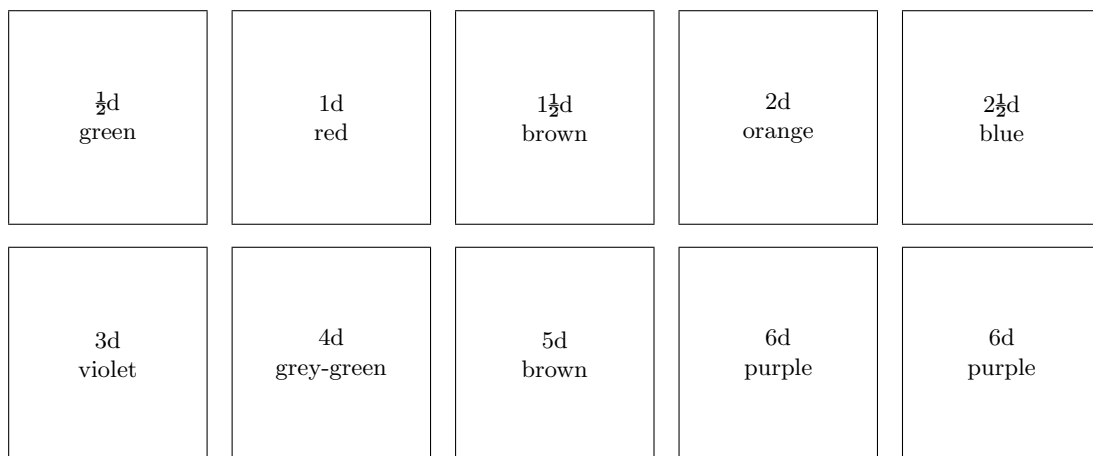

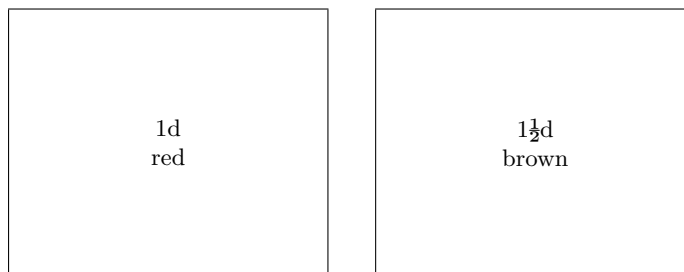

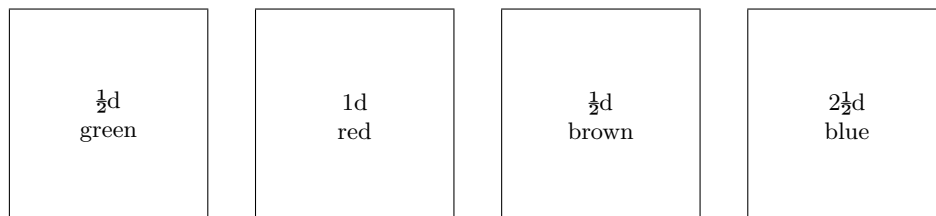

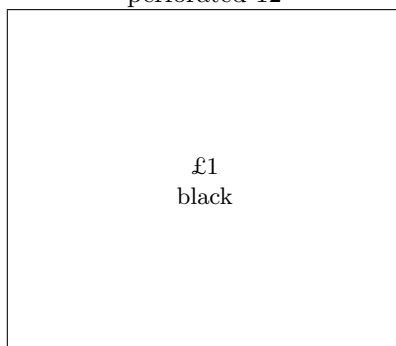

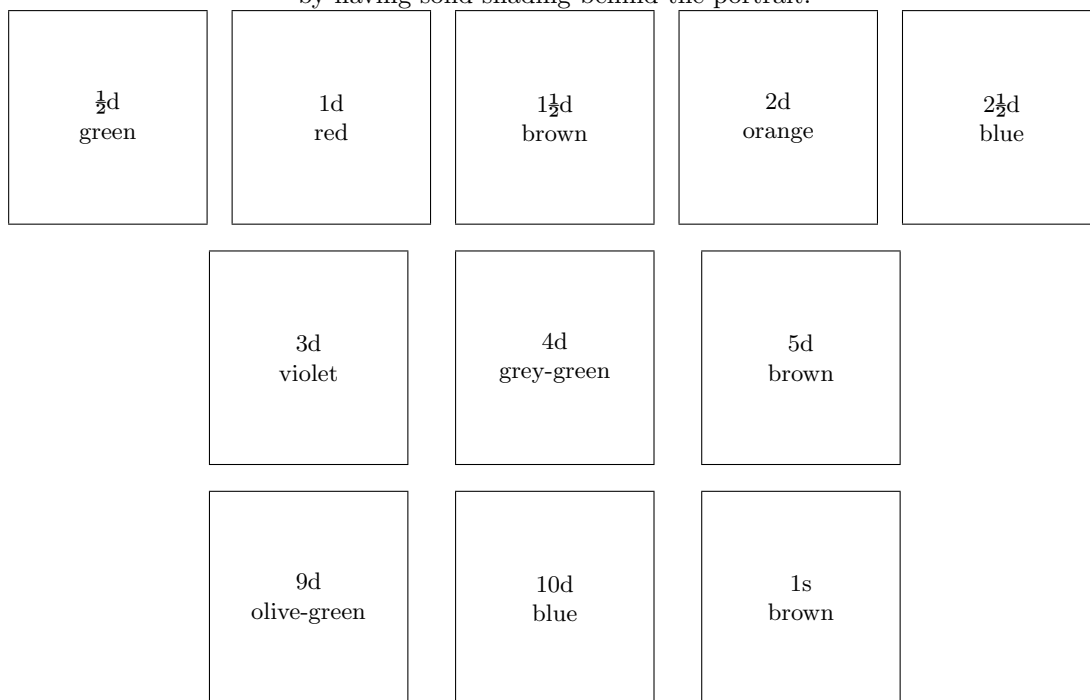

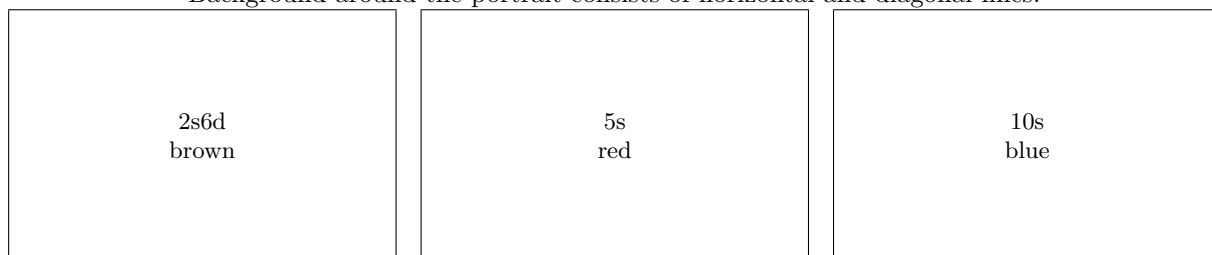
